SUBJECT: STATUS UPDATE ON ENHANCED CONTINUOUS VOTER REGISTRATION PHASE II - WEEK 1

The Commission rolled out the second and final phase of the Enhanced Continuous Voter Registration (ECVR) exercise from 17th January to 6th February 2022 in all the 1450 County Assembly Wards (CAWs), institutions of higher learning and Huduma centres countrywide.

In addition, the Commission commenced, on 21st January 2022, voter registration for citizens residing outside Kenya at Embassies, High Commissions and Consulates in United States of America (USA), Qatar, Germany, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi and South Sudan. However, registration in the United Kingdom started on 24th January 2022.

Registration of voters for citizens residing outside the country has not kicked off, as earlier scheduled. in United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Canada due to the prevailing COVID-19 containment measures instituted in the two countries. The Commission will advise on when the registration exercise shall be conducted in UAE and Canada once the COVID 19 containment measures are eased.

The Commission targeted to register 6 million new voters out of which 1,519,294 were registered in the first phase of ECVR. The current phase (ECVR II) targets to register as voters 4,480,706 eligible Kenyans as distributed per County in table I. For the last 7 days, the Commission registered 229,843 new voters against the weekly target of 1,493,569. Further, the Commission received 34,928 requests for transfer and 345 applications for change of particulars.
