



POLLING STATIONS WITHOUT TELECOMMUNICATION NETWORK

Regulation 21 of the Elections (Technology) Regulations, 2017 requires the Commission to inform the stakeholders and publish areas where there is no telecommunication network.

The KIEMS (Kenya Integrated Elections Management System) network infrastructure requires a minimum of 3G /4G GSM network infrastructure to be put in place to support result transmission during the election day of 9th August 2022. 96% of IEBC registration Centers is covered by Safaricom PLC, while Airtel Networks Ltd covers 75% and Telkom Kenya Networks Ltd covers 62% according to mapping done by the Communications Authority of Kenya (CA).

Pursuant to the above regulation and CA mapping , NOTICE is hereby given to the public that a total of 1272 out of 46,229 polling stations do not have 3G/4G Mobile broadband coverage. The Commission will use the available satellite technology to support Result Transmission for polling stations with no 3G/4G Mobile Broadband coverage/GSM network.
