ACCREDITATION OF CIVIC / VOTER EDUCATION PROVIDERS

The Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC), is in the process of accrediting voter education providers. The Commission invites applications from eligible non-state actors for accreditation as Voter Education Providers.

Eligibility

Interested organizations should:

- i. Attach a copy of a valid registration certificate.
- ii. Have voter/civic education as one of their objects.
- iii. Have at least six months demonstrable experience in providing civic/voter education
- iv. Provide their postal address, physical location and contact persons.
- v. Attach the organization profile detailing their technical and financial strength to provide voter/civic education
- vi. Attach a copy of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate.
- vii. Sign a code of conduct for voter educators before certification.

Application Procedure
