The Chairperson on his opening statement briefed the bidders on the intention of the Commission to procure a vendor for supply and delivery of ballot papers; register of voters; statutory election result declaration forms to be used at the polling station; election and referendum result declaration forms to be used at the constituency, county and national tallying center - a three-year framework contract as per tender no. IEBC/OT/002/FC/21/2021/2022.

The Chair noted that as at July, 2021 the total number of registered voters stands at 19.6 million. He further added that the Commission is planning to carry out voter's registration and estimate number of registered voters is expected to be a range of 25 to 30 million.

The Chair added that the current no. of polling stations stands at 40,883 and this number is expected to raise to 53,000 polling station as result of the new voter's enrollment.

The Chair emphasized that the Commission had given indicative quantities in the tender document for evaluation and comparison purposes only as outlined below;

- a) Ballot papers 3000 pieces
- b) Forms- 6 pieces
- c) Register of Voters 1
